Smillie Family Education Award support applicants who have resided in a rural Canadian community and are entering their first or second year of a full-time undergraduate degree or diploma program at a qualified Canadian post-secondary institution in a program that can lead to a career in agriculture, education, or health care. Applicants must demonstrate leadership and volunteerism in school and the community. Three awards valued at \$1,500 each, applied directly to tuition.

The deadline to apply to each award is June 1st at midnight.
