ⁱⁱ Stepping Stones supports projects that help people feel they belong in their neighbourhoods or communities. We look for factors like new leaders from that neighbourhood or community stepping forward, the likelihood of new friendships being made within the project, and a project design that welcomes in a diversity of people from that neighbourhood or community
